

ADMISSION POLICY CIMS Multan – CMC & CDC

Test Requirements:

Appearing in NUMS MDCAT is MANDATORY for all MBBS / BDS students. The test will be conducted in the following major cities:-

Punjab: Islamabad / Rawalpindi, Lahore, Multan, Faisalabad, Sargodha.

Sindh: Karachi, Hyderabad, Sukkur.

Balochistan: Quetta.

KPK: Peshawar

For NUMS Entry Test Dates and other eligibility details, please visit the NUMS website (www.numspak.edu.pk).

Eligibility for applicants:

The applicants must qualify for the followings:

- Passing NUMS MDCAT with a minimum of 55% marks.
- Passing F.Sc (Pre-Medical)/ Equivalent exam with minimum 60% marks.

Seat Distribution:

- Open Merit / overseas / Foreign National (as per Notification of NUMS)
- MC/ PC/ Shuhada / Wards of the army (as per Notification of PA/W&R Dte)

Confirmation of Admission

- The induction will be centralized through NUMS. The enrolment of applicants will be online through the e-portal of NUMS.
- The merit list will be furnished by the admission cell of NUMS.
- The merit list will be displayed on the CIMS Multan website (www.cims.pk) when received from NUMS.
- Selected candidates will be called merit-wise via official e-mails only.
- Admission of the selected candidates will be confirmed only after they have deposited the college admission, tuition fee, and other charges as prescribed, within specific days of the announcement of the merit.



- If a seat is not confirmed by the due date, it will be offered to the next candidate on the merit list.
- Once a student is admitted to the college, his/her Matric, F.Sc, or equivalence and other certificates will be verified by respective boards by NUMS. If the documents are found incorrect, the admission will be canceled and the fees/dues will not be refunded.
- In case of a tie between students with the same merit position, preference will be given to the student who will be older.
- The admission process will be completed in due dates and no student will be admitted after the admissions are closed.
